

# **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS-AT-LARGE**

## **Authority**

The bylaws of the Federal Laboratory Consortium for Technology Transfer (FLC) provide the authority for Members-at-Large (MALs) (Article V, Section 3 c.)).

## **Purpose**

The purpose of a MAL is to represent the general membership and to aid in governing the Consortium.

## **Election**

- **Eligibility for Office**

Eligibility for election as a nationally elected officer shall be limited to Laboratory Representatives, Agency Representatives, and Consortium participants.

- **Frequency of Election**

MALs shall be elected every two years in conjunction with the national meeting.

Three MALs shall be elected in odd-numbered years.

Three MALs shall be elected in even-numbered years.

- **Approval of Candidacy**

The nomination of a MAL must be approved by the nominee's organization of employment.

## **Responsibility**

MALs shall:

1. Serve as voting members of the Executive Board (EB).
2. Chair ad hoc committees at the discretion of the Consortium Chair or Vice-Chair.
3. Assist the Regional Coordinator of the region in which they are located.
4. Participate in FLC regional and national technology transfer activities as appropriate.
5. Serve on at least one Standing Committee.
6. Submit a joint quarterly report on their activities in the quarterly report format.
